Notice to Residents and Business Owners on Lamoreaux Drive between Alpine Avenue and West River Drive

The Kent County Road Commission and Plainfield Township have contracted Kamminga and Roodvoets Construction to replace water main and resurface Lamoreaux Drive between Alpine Ave and West River Drive (water main replacement west limit is Bekinshire Drive).

Project Schedule

<u>Phase 1:</u>	April 1, 2019 Start June 1, 2019 Approximate Complete
<u>Phase 2:</u>	June 3, 2019 Approximate Start/ October 26, 2019 Complete

Phase 1 (detour through traffic and open to local traffic)- Water main replacement between Bekinshire Drive and the railroad crossing on the north side of Lamoreaux Drive and between the railroad crossing and West River Drive on the south side of Lamoreaux Drive. Replacement of natural gas line on south and north sides of Lamoreaux Drive. Bus traffic will be maintained.

Phase 2 (two-way traffic maintained) - Continue water main work and water services. Cold mill existing asphalt pavement and place 2 courses of new pavement. Some short-term weekend closures may be required for water main lateral work.

Water Service Interruption

During construction there will be times when the water service to your property will be interrupted. You will be notified of scheduled service disruptions with a white card hung on your door, typically at least 2 days before the shut off is scheduled. These cards will give more information about the timing and duration of the shut off and how to contact the Township. While it is the intention of the water department to only have scheduled disruptions to service, emergencies do occur and may require immediate shut off. If this occurs, the Township will do its best to inform the residents of the situation.

Mailboxes

For residents between Alpine Ave and the railroad tracks, temporary mailboxes will be placed at Bekinshire Dr & Netherfield St. For residents between the railroad tracks and West River, temp. mailboxes will be placed at McCrellus Ave & Lamoreaux Dr. This relocation is necessary due to the proximity of current mailboxes to the utility and water main work.

Sprinklers: Sprinklers located near the roadway should be flagged to make their location visible to the contractor. Please note that the property owner is responsible for any damage the project may cause to sprinkler systems within the road right-of-way.
